How does Examity work?

Examity Fees

Examity charges \$15 for the first hour and \$7 for any additional hours.

Exam Length Fee*

1.5 hours	\$22
2 hours	\$22
2.5 hours	\$29
3 hours	\$29

*All fees are in USD.

The exam fee is payable by any major debit or credit card, during the booking of the exam on the Examity website. We recommend that students book exams at least a few days prior to the writing date. Examity asks for 24 hours notice, but a rush fee of \$5 may be paid if the student needs to schedule with less than 24 hours notice.

Writing An Exam with Examity

On the day of the exam, students should log into Examity 10-15 minutes in advance to complete the authentication process. At this point students will speak with the remote proctor, via microphone and webcam, to confirm their identity. Students will be supervised and recorded for the duration of the exam.

Any additional resources that can be used during the exam, such as a formula sheet, will be provided by the proctor.

Students may ask the proctor questions related to technical assistance or issues. The exam recording will be reviewed after the writing period to verify that all rules and regulations have been followed. It may take up to 48 hours for the exam summary to be released.

Note: Students who have IEPs should contact Kanata Academy Administrator before scheduling with Examity in order to ensure that all accommodations can be met. If an IEP allows the student additional time in which to complete tests, students will not be charged for the additional time required.

Technical Requirements

To use Examity, students must:

- use a computer with a webcam and a microphone (both built-in and external are fine). This can be checked at www.testmycam.com.
- use a desktop computer or laptop (not a tablet or mobile device).
- take the exam from a location with sufficient internet speed: at least 3 MPS upload and download speed. This can be tested at www.speedtest.net.
